**Call to Order**

- Kevin Bergschneider called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. It was determined that a quorum of the Board was present.

**Approval of May 2011 Meeting Minutes (Sarah Dominick)**

A motion was made by Mark Hartman and a seconded by Tod Phinney to approve the minutes of the May 13, 2011 RMSAWWA Board Meeting. Motion carried.

**Director’s Report (Martin Garcia)**

- Section Breakfast at ACE – Currently at least 14 signed up.
- Board of Directors’ at ACE will be voting on several items.
  - Affiliation Agreement Section 8 (which covers what to do with a section that is out of compliance). This was reviewed by RMS last fall.
  - Disposition of committees that were under the APC. The recommendation is to continue the Canadian Affairs Committee, and to combine the Membership and Section Services Committees into one committee called the Member Engagement & Development Committee. Both committees would report directly to the EC.
  - Winter Board Meeting site for 2014. Recommendation is for Austin, TX.
  - Section newsletter program. AWWA wants to get more sections involved, with a goal of making it profitable for AWWA by 2013, with payback from losses by 2016. RMSAWWA/RMWEA is one of the sections they would want to go for when our contract with Apogee expires. They would want to start discussions this fall.
  - 2012 dues. Recommendation is for a 3% increase for individual members, raising active members from \$165 to \$170. No increase for student, life, or honorary members. Service Providers with over \$3M revenue will increase by 10%, under \$3M will see no increase. Utilities under 25,000 connections will see no increase,

- those 25,000 and over will see 3%. All these increases will be enough to keep the association's head above water, net income will not increase much.
- Life Members. This is currently the fastest-growing member category, and it is not sustainable. The recommendation is to have a minimum age (65) as well as years of service, to achieve life membership, and to have current and future Life Members pay dues of \$85. Life Members who are retired could convert to the retiree category and pay \$32 or \$44, depending on whether they get Journal AWWA.

### RECENT ACTIVITIES

- Arapahoe County conducted a financial audit of the Get Into Water! initiative on May 24. This is standard operating procedure for grants using American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds. The audit went very well—all required documentation was submitted and approved.
- Ms. Fahrenbruch met with representatives from Denver Water on May 23 to discuss the Water Utility Science Program. Denver Water is open to providing assistance with course material review, internships and other activities.
- Ms. Fahrenbruch met with Emily Griffith Opportunity School representatives and the new Water Utility Science Program (WUSP) instructor, Jeff Barnier on May 26 to begin work on Fall courses. Mr. Barnier will be developing course materials for Water Treatment and Wastewater Treatment.
- Mr. Pier, Ms. Fahrenbruch and Paul Fanning (Pueblo Board of Water Works) met with Kenneth Morris on May 23 to discuss the website project. The project is underway and will be completed by June 30. The Get Into Water! website will be developed in a new software package that will allow us to post documents and resources. It will also be co-branded with the RMSAWWA and RMWEA logos.
- Ms. Fahrenbruch met with Karen Main to review the Supervisory Program Survey that will be distributed to Colorado utilities tomorrow. The Supervisory Program draft Comparative Study was completed last week.

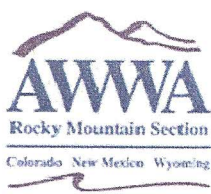
